

This Lent...Encounter the Inspiring Legacy of Julia Greeley on Saturday, March 28, 2026 from 10 am—3 pm. Step into the remarkable story of

“Denver’s Angel of Charity” during this unique and deeply moving Lenten pilgrimage across Denver. Traveling by comfortable coach bus, pilgrims will visit 19 significant locations connected to Julia’s life, including her boarding house, Sacred Heart Parish, and her final resting place at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. This pilgrimage will be led by Fr. Blaine Burkey, OFM Cap., the Capuchin Franciscan priest who has devoted decades to advancing Julia’s cause for canonization. Now 90 years old, Fr. Blaine offers powerful storytelling and spiritual reflection that brings Julia’s life of heroic charity to life. Born into slavery and freed after the Civil War, Julia came to Denver with little of her own. Despite blindness in one eye and severe arthritis, she quietly served the poor by delivering food, coal, and clothing—often at night using her little red wagon to protect the dignity of those she helped. Her life of humility and sacrificial love continues to inspire today. Pilgrimage includes: Spiritual reflections led by Fr. Blaine; Charter coach transportation departing from the Capuchin Admin. Office; Lunch at Sacred Heart Church; a copy of Fr. Blaine’s booklet, “An Hour with Julia Greeley”. Tickets are \$85/person. Seating is limited. Common Practices Explained

The Sign of the Cross

“I claim you for Christ by the sign of his cross.” These words from the Rite of Baptism, spoken as the priest traces a cross on the infant’s forehead, perfectly communicate the significance of that simple, familiar action. In signing the cross, we claim ourselves again and again for Christ, unite ourselves with His sacrifice on Calvary, and confess his victory over death.

Christians have been making the sign of the cross since ancient times, as evidenced by writings from Tertullian, Hippolytus and St. Cyprian. The ritual action is not only an important component of formal liturgies and sacramental rites, but also a daily devotional practice whereby the faithful invoke the blessing and protection of God.

In the Latin rite, it is made either with a movement of the full hand from one’s forehead, breast and shoulders (going right to left) or with the thumb tracing the cross on the forehead, lips and breast.
